Body of the text: one-column format, Times New Roman, normal, type size 14 pt, line spacing 17 pt. The first line is indented (0,5 cm).

Footnotes (no endnotes, arabic numerals): type size 12 pt., line spacing 14 pt.

Within the text the reference should be to surname, year of publication and page number, e. g. (Voss 2004: 125)
