

China's new regulation on the protection of personal information

Legal systems around the world are grappling with the need to provide increasing protection for personal data, defined as the "new oil" in the digital transition. In recent years, the People's Republic of China has also adopted its own data regulation in a similar way to the European Union and distancing itself from the U.S. model of data protection, aimed at protecting the rights and interests of its citizens while at the same time strengthening the role of the Party-State in and out of cyberspace.
