Community Participation in World Heritage Sites

Methods and comparative analysis with the People's Republic of China

Abstract

The UNESCO 1972 Convention Concerning the Protection of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage emphasizes the importance of Communities in implementing the Convention. This research will create a framework for the participation processes and the methodology to assess them. It also provides a comparative analysis with the People's Republic of China to investigate similarities and differences in the participation of communities. The final objective is to identify strategies to improve local communities' participation in implementing the 1972 Convention in Italy.

The discussion will focus on concept mapping in Designing Qualitative Research as a methodological strategy.
