Research

We stimulate and promote research on China from various Social Science and Humanities disciplines (including economics, politics, law, international relations, business), while also including innovation and technology perspectives. Our approach is interdisciplinary, international, and intersectoral, aiming to achieve both cognitive and descriptive goals, as well as formative and educational purposes.

Key Research Topics include: industrial policy; political economy; macro-economic trends; China US and EU relations; China and the international order; geopolitics of technological innovation; and Chinese law.

We strongly believe in the diffusion of the principles of European Research Area. Therefore, we are used to working in partnership with European and Chinese institution thanks to EU funded projects,
