The University of Macerata was **established in 1290** and has, down through the centuries, grown and consolidated its reputation right up to our own times which have seen the opening of new academic departments, innovative degree courses at undergraduate and graduate levels which reflect today's evolving international academic disciplines and community needs.

Today, UniMC stands as an esteemed institution with a rich history and a strong commitment to academic excellence. Unique in Italy, UniMC is a university entirely dedicated to the social sciences and the humanities, offering degree courses that span from law to education, from political science to the languages, literature, and philosophy, from cultural heritage to economics, from communication science and linguistics to tourism.

We offer 8 degree courses entirely taught in English:

- 2 single-cycle master's degree courses
- 14 two-year master's degree programmes
- 4 double/multiple master's degree programmes

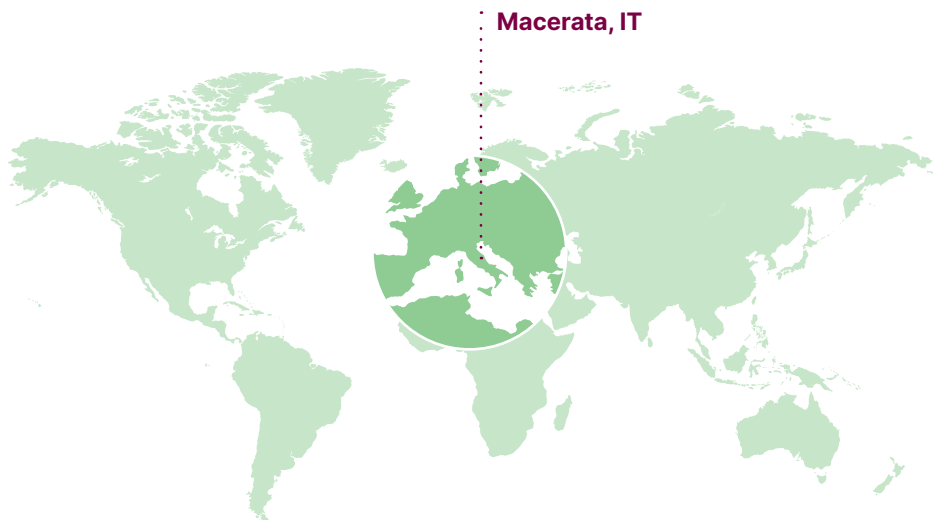

DOUBLE OR MULTIPLE DEGREE COURSES

Double or multiple degree programmes consist of an integrated study path created through international agreements with foreign Universities. Eligible students attend part of their studies at the partner University. These programmes allow students to obtain an Italian degree and one or more foreign degree(s). Admission to a double or multiple degree programme is granted on a competitive basis and is achieved through the procedures described in specific calls for application launched by Departments yearly.

ENROL AT UNIMC

UniMC offers a wide range of degree programmes in the fields of the social sciences and the humanities.

In Italy, to be eligible for bachelor's level studies, you must hold a high school qualification issued after a minimum of 12 years of schooling; for master's level studies, you must hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent foreign qualification with specific curricular requirements awarded by an accredited higher education institution, enabling you to proceed to the next level of education in the country where it was issued.

APPLY TO UNIMC

Step 1: pre-admission application

If you hold an international qualification, submit your pre-admission application between the autumn and spring of the academic year preceding the one you wish to enrol in. The procedure is easy and is done completely online on the dedicated portal: **apply.unimc.it**. Completed and submitted applications are evaluated by a selection committee in line with the specific admission requirements of each degree programme; if your entry qualification is deemed satisfactory, you will be able to proceed with the next steps.

Step 2: pre-enrolment on Universitaly (for visa applicants only)

If you reside abroad and need a visa to study in Italy, you must apply for pre-enrolment through the portal Universitaly.it. This step is necessary for the subsequent request for a visa for study reasons in Italy to be made to the relevant Italian Embassy/Consulate abroad. The pre-enrolment procedure starts in the spring and follows the terms set by the Italian Ministry of University and Research.

Step 3: enrolment at UniMC

From 15 July to 31 October, you can register at UniMC and enrol in the chosen degree course through the online portal **studenti.unimc.it**; you can then send the required documentation to complete the enrolment to the Departmental Registrar's Office. Tuition fees and Financial Aid

TUITION FEES

Article 34 of the Italian Constitution states that "capable and deserving students, including those lacking financial resources, have the right to access higher education". In accordance with this principle, UniMC makes sure that tuition fees are not an obstacle to enrollment for economically disadvantaged students. The maximum annual tuition fee for full-time enrolment in a bachelor's or master's degree programme is approximately € 1,600 per year. Yearly tuition fees are paid in 4 instalments:

- 1st instalment deadline: 31 October (€156 which covers a € 140 regional tax for the right to study and a € 16 tax stamp)
- 2nd instalment deadline: 31 January
- 3rd instalment deadline: 31 March
- 4th instalment deadline: 31 May.

FEES REDUCTION

The total tuition fees can be considerably reduced if you meet specific conditions. All international students residing abroad may apply for a reduction of the yearly tuition fees when enrolment and merit requirements are satisfied.

The 2024/2025 fee reductions are as specified below:

- Students from an extremely poor and developing country pay € 156 per year
- Students from a non-OECD member country pay € 156 per year
- Students from an OECD member country pay € 611 per year

Scholarship awardees are exempted from paying fees.

UNIMC SCHOLARSHIPS

UniMC supports capable and deserving international students wishing to pursue their education in Italy.

In particular, the most talented international students enrolling in the first year of a bachelor's or a master's degree programme are awarded 20 scholarships worth €10,000.00, including a total exemption from payment of fees for the entire duration of their studies.

INVEST YOUR TALENT IN ITALY SCHOLARSHIPS

UniMC is a partner of the Invest Your Talent in Italy (IYT) programme, which offers students from Azerbaijan, Armenia, Brazil, Colombia, Egypt, Ethiopia, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Iran, Kazakhstan, Mexico, People's Republic of China, Republic of Korea, Tunisia, Turkey and Vietnam the opportunity to attend selected master's programmes taught in English. The IYT programme is promoted by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation - Directorate General for Public and Cultural Diplomacy, the Ministry of University and Research, ITA – Italian Trade Agency, and Uni-Italia, and combines university lectures with practical on-the-job training with an Italian company. The call for applications is launched yearly.

GRANTS FOR FOREIGN AND ITALIAN CITIZENS LIVING ABROAD AWARDED BY THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT (MAECI SCHOLARSHIP)

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI) offers grants in favour of foreign citizens and Italian citizens living abroad (IRE) for the 2024/25 academic year in order to foster international cooperation in cultural, scientific and technological fields, to promote the Italian language and culture and to support the Italian economic system in the world. Grants are offered to complete study courses and research/training programs in public or legally recognized Italian educational institutions. Scholarships are available for those wishing to enrol in academic courses taught on the Italian territory only.

ERDIS SCHOLARSHIPS
