Active ageing and tourism are topical and highly relevant issues, directly linked to the role culture can play in improving the quality of life of senior citizens. The contribution that tourism can make is certainly important, especially in a context in which the average age of the world's population is steadily increasing, and this trend is expected to accelerate in the coming decades. Although many cities have invested in improving their accessibility, focusing especially on visitors with physical and sensory disabilities, nevertheless a large part of their audience has not been adequately considered: the elderly. Few cities are in fact designed to welcome people over the age of 65, despite the fact that a considerable proportion of their visitors belong to this age group; moreover, in villages and inland areas the attention given to this type of audience is still insufficient. The research, which is part of the PNRR project 'Innovation, digitalisation and sustainability for the diffused economy in Central Italy - VITALITY', has the primary objective of proposing models of sustainable tourism for the elderly, which can be used as guidelines by municipalities, tourism boards, etc.
