Title: Ars dictandi and grammar: theory and (proto-)syntactic terminology in medieval rhetorical treatises

Offer description:

The inquiry about the development of syntactical-grammatical terms and theories in Europe leads on a path which had its greatest moment during the XVII century in the School of Port-Royal. Nonetheless, another crucial phase has to be found in the late Middle Ages, when new rhetorical treatises quickly spread along from Italy to the rest of the continent, along with doctrines and terms they contained. The so called *ars dictandi* reaches France and the valley of the Loire since the XII century, and there it displays a peculiar attention towards grammatical issues, both macro- and micro-syntactical, bringing to the emergence of early syntactical theories with a reasonable degree of consistency and analytical attitude. A vast number of terms coming from these treatises can be put in relation with the key-concepts that the School of Port-Royal established in the Western logical-syntactical tradition, to verify, in an evolutionary perspective, whether the medieval circulation of grammatical ideas in France pairs with the early awareness of a syntactic level of language analysis. The terminological corpus output of the research will include notions and definitions of *clausola*, *distinctio*, *constructio*, *regimen* and *convenientia* in addition to the set of *figures* as syntactic devices, with the aim of reconstructing a continuity in the history of syntactic theories in Europe on the trail of linguistic ideas that prelude the appearance of portrealist grammar.
