Title: Artificial Intelligence at the service of culture: digitisation and recovery of Leopardi's heritage.
Description and digitisation of the CNSL Multimedia Archive

Offer description:

The selected research fellow will be responsible for the inventory and description of the multimedia archive of the National Centre for Leopardi Studies in Recanati (about 400 documents including VHS, audiotapes, CDs, DVDs, etc.), and for the subsequent digitisation of the documents and metadata of the digital files, as well as for the transfer of the latter to the platforms of the Archival Administration (and, through it, to the National Digital Library and the Biblioteca Digitale Leopardiana). At the same time, the research fellow will be in charge of studying the functioning of the METS standard, in order to define a specific administrative and management metadata model for multimedia items, in dialogue with the other members of the project in which he/she will be included in order to evaluate different strategies for applying Artificial Intelligence to the automated creation of metadata for this specific category of documents.
