Title: Archaeological research in the internal and external area of Villa Vitali in Fermo (FM, Italy)

Offer description - Funded by the European Union - Next Generation EU - PNRR mission 1, component 3

The research will focus on the historical-archaeological reconstruction of the main phases that followed one another in ancient times, from the pre-Roman age to the late-imperial one, in the area of the eastern suburb of Firmum Picenum (Fermo, FM), where from the second half of the 19th century the Villa of the Vitali family would be built.

In particular, we will proceed with: general recognition of the state of the art through a spoliation of existing archival and bibliographic documentation; collection, analysis, study, graphic and photographic survey of any archaeological evidence still existing in the Villa and its Park; geophysical and cartographic survey of the area; study of photographic albums, dating back to the beginning of the last century, relating to the archaeological collection of the Vitali family.
