The research, carried out as part of the PRIN 2022 PNRR project (FRAME - FRAGMENT AND MEMORY. VIRTUAL SPACE AND MURALS IN THE MONASTERY OF SAN VINCENZO AL VOLTURNO (8th - 11th CENTURY) n. P2022MYF7B - CUP D53D23021370001), aims to support the ongoing studies on the virtual reconstruction of the spaces of the Monastery of San Vincenzo al Volturno (IS), in particular the *Basilica maior* with its semi-annular crypt and atrium.

The research activity must be in the following areas: analysis of the early medieval and early Romanesque architectural and sculptural context in Italy; analysis of archival material; bibliographical cataloguing; collaboration in the use of surveying and measuring instruments; processing of the data obtained and analysed.

The research activity takes place between Rome, Naples and San Vincenzo al Volturno (Isernia).
