Title: "Italian L2 and care work: training paths for migrant caregivers"

Offer description:

The research activity will be carried out in the framework of the project SAFINA - *Smart solutions and educational programmes for anti-fragility and inclusivity* (Spoke 7) in which Unimc is a partner. The scholarship holder will collaborate in the research activities of Work Package 2 (*Economy, industries and culture for active elderly people*), in particular with regard to Task 2.3 (*Social enterprises and social welfare services*), aimed at proposing innovative solutions for the provision of services in the care of the elderly with fragility.

The research activities will concern the development of training programmes in Italian L2 for family assistants with a migrant background (*migrant caregivers*) engaged in care work with frail elderly people. The research fellow will assist the Unimc research team of Task 2.3 in the implementation of the expected outputs of the project, with particular reference to the development of guidelines and training materials in Italian L2 as a language for work in the above-mentioned field, for the use of institutions and bodies engaged in the training of caregivers, as well as the design of a digital environment for their use.
