**Title:** Adolescent Female Development Pathways in Kenya

### **Offer description:**

Observing female development processes in selected geo-cultural contexts in Kenya, allows to analyze the intertwining of educational poverty, gender inequality, and processes of subjectivation. The project aims to explore the spaces and times of female adolescence in Kenya, both by identifying the educational resources present in specific community settings and by examining identity-building processes and agency. The project, which takes the form of action research, integrates pedagogical reflection, gender studies from a transcultural perspective, and decolonial concerns that challenge the centrality of Western educational models. The goal is to create opportunities for dialogue and collaboration with selected local communities to co-design educational strategies and practices that can ensure processes of female empowerment
