INTERVIEW ASSESSMENT CRITERIA	1. Originality and logical development of the project in relation to the chosen research topic
	2. Assessment of the educational and working profile, including outside the academic context
	3. Experience in terms of national and international mobility, congruent with the candidate's curriculum and the project submitted
	4. Proficiency test concerning the knowledge of the stated foreign language/s
	5. Consistency of prior study with the chosen research topic
Specific requirements for the competitive exam	Knowledge of at least one foreign language, from among English, Spanish and French.
Obligations for enrollees	Attendance of PhD training activities, and, normally, a minimum of 3 months experience abroad.
