

**Call for applications for the National Doctoral Programme in
Teaching & Learning Sciences: Inclusion, Technologies, Educational Research and Evaluation
(XLII cycle - academic years 2026/2029)**

Art. 1

Establishment of the Programme

1. A public selection procedure is hereby announced for admission to the National Doctoral Programme in Teaching & Learning Sciences: Inclusion, Technologies, Educational Research and Evaluation, XLII cycle, academic years 2026/2029, as illustrated in the doctoral programme description (Annex A).
The doctoral programme will last three years, beginning on 1 November 2026 and ending on 31 October 2029.
2. Positions available:
30 positions with scholarship, each linked to a specific operational site and a specific research topic;
10 positions without scholarship, each linked to a specific operational site and a specific research topic.
The allocation of the available positions among the various partner institutions and curricula is set out in Annex B.
3. Details and obligations pertaining to the positions available for each curriculum are set out in the individual curriculum descriptions (Annexes C, D, E, F, G, and H), which form an integral part of this call.
4. This call for applications constitutes official notification for all legal purposes. Any changes, updates or additions will be published exclusively on the webpage: <https://www.unimc.it/it/dottorato-di-ricerca/ammissione-ai-corsi/ciclo-42-din/din2026>.
5. The University applies the principles set out in the [European Charter for Researchers](#) and in the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers and participates in the European Commission's Human Resources Strategy for Researchers – [HRS4R](#). The University of Macerata holds the European "HR Excellence in Research" award, which confirms its commitment to an open, transparent, inclusive and researcher-oriented research environment.

Art. 2

Admission requirements

1. Eligible candidates for this call for applications are graduates holding a Specialist Degree, Master's Degree, single-cycle Master's Degree, or a degree obtained under the regulations in force before [Ministerial Decree No. 509 of 3 November 1999](#); a second-level academic qualification awarded by institutions belonging to the AFAM sector (Higher Artistic and Musical Education); or an equivalent non-Italian second-level academic qualification, such as a Master's Degree, awarded by a foreign university.
2. The eligibility of foreign degrees is verified by the Admission Committee **solely** for the purpose of admission to the Doctoral programme, in compliance with the legislation in force in Italy and in the country where the qualification was awarded, as well as with international treaties or agreements on the recognition of qualifications for the continuation of studies.
3. All candidates will be provisionally admitted to the selection process and will be excluded from the doctorate if, upon verification, it turns out that their qualifications do not meet the requirements for admission to third-level courses.
4. Candidates who obtain the required qualification referred to in paragraph 1 by the enrolment deadline for the Doctoral programme, set out in Art. 6, paragraph 1 below, may also participate in the selection procedure. In this case, admission to the selection procedure is conditional, and any subsequent enrolment is governed by Art. 6 below.

Art. 3

Application

1. Applications shall be submitted, in either Italian or English, exclusively online via <https://pica.cineca.it/unimc/dot-2026-din/>, by enclosing a copy of a valid identity document (EU identity card, EU driving licence, passport or residence permit) clearly showing its expiry date and by paying the **compulsory application fee of EUR 20.00** through the online procedure **by 11:59 p.m. (Italian time) on 19 August 2026**.
2. Applications submitted in a manner that does not comply with the requirements set out in the previous paragraph will not be considered.
3. Candidates shall be excluded from the selection procedure if, by the application deadline, they fail to submit one or more of the following:
 - the application form, completed in accordance with Articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree No. 445 of 28 December 2000;
 - a self-certification of the Italian academic qualification referred to in Art. 2, paragraph 1, or, for candidates who have not yet obtained the degree, a declaration of the expected date of award of the qualification;
 - declarations and documents concerning academic qualifications obtained abroad, as specified in paragraph 8 below;
 - a valid identity document;
 - payment of the application fee.
4. **Application fees will not be reimbursed under any circumstances.**
5. Candidates may submit one application only. In the event of multiple applications, only the last submission in chronological order, will be considered valid.
6. Candidates intending to apply for a scholarship position **must not have previously received** a scholarship or partial scholarship for a doctoral programme. This condition must be self-declared in the application.
7. Candidates holding an Italian academic qualification must provide a self-certification listing the examinations taken, for the purpose of assessing their prior academic studies.
8. Candidates holding, or expecting to obtain, an academic qualification abroad are required to declare and upload a copy of the **second-level qualification** giving access to the Doctoral programme, together with transcripts or certificates listing the examinations taken, and a copy of the **first-level qualification**, together with transcripts or certificates listing the examinations taken. Each document must be accompanied by a translation into Italian or English.
9. Qualifications, publications and any other relevant documents must be submitted in electronic PDF format and attached **exclusively** to the online application.
10. Without prejudice to Art. 2, paragraph 4 above, concerning the degree required for admission, all other submitted qualifications must have been obtained by the deadline of this call.
11. As part of the online application, candidates must select a curriculum and a research topic from among those available within the selected curriculum and must submit a research proposal related to the chosen research topic (maximum 13,000 characters, including spaces), with specific reference to the epistemological and methodological framework.
12. **Candidates must also indicate in the online application whether they wish to attend the interview in person or by videoconference.**
13. No amendments or additions may be made to the application after submission. Any amendment requires the completion and submission of a new application, including all necessary information, and payment of a new application fee, by the deadline indicated in paragraph 1 of this Article. The new application shall replace the previous one.

14. The validity of applications will be assessed by the University administration after the submission deadline specified in paragraph 1. The University reserves the right to verify the accuracy of the information provided in the application form. Any false declaration shall be prosecuted in accordance with current legislation and shall result in exclusion from the selection procedure or, if verification takes place after enrolment, from the Doctoral programme.

16. The University shall not be held liable for technical problems, internet issues or service interruptions that are not attributable to the University. The University shall also not be held liable for any failure to communicate resulting from an incorrect email address provided by the candidate, or for delays or problems caused by third parties, unforeseeable events or force majeure.

Art. 4 **Admission Committee**

1. The Admission Committee is appointed by the Rector and shall include foreign members or members not affiliated with the partner institutions, pursuant to Art. 11, paragraph 3 of [Ministerial Decree No. 226 of 14 December 2021](#).
2. The Admission Committee is chaired by the Coordinator of the Doctoral programme or his/her delegate.
3. The appointment decree of the Admission Committee will be published, after the deadline of the call, on the following webpage: <https://www.unimc.it/it/dottorato-di-ricerca/ammissione-ai-corsi/ciclo-42-din/din2026>.

Art. 5 **Selection**

1. Admission to the Doctoral programme shall take place through a selection procedure based on qualifications and examinations, aimed at assessing the candidate's preparation, ability and aptitude for research.
2. Each application will be subject to a preliminary assessment and will be declared eligible or ineligible for interview, on the basis of the criteria set out in Annex A.
3. The results of the preliminary assessment will be published **exclusively** on the webpage <https://www.unimc.it/it/dottorato-di-ricerca/ammissione-ai-corsi/ciclo-42-din/din2026> and such publication shall constitute official notification for all purposes.
4. Candidates who successfully pass the preliminary assessment referred to in paragraph 2 of this Article are admitted to the interview. The Admission Committee will examine and evaluate those candidates on the basis of the interview evaluation criteria specified in Annex A.
5. **Candidates admitted to the interview are required to attend with a valid identity document on the date and at the time indicated in the doctoral programme description (Annex A), which also specifies the interview venue and the videoconference link. The interview schedule published in the doctoral programme description (Annex A) constitutes official notification to candidates; no further notice will be provided.**
6. The interviews shall be held in Italian or English and in the mode (either in person or by videoconference) selected by the candidate in the online application. The Committee shall also assess English language proficiency where the interview is held in Italian, and Italian language proficiency where the interview is held in English.

7. If a candidate does not attend the interview, they shall be deemed to have withdrawn from the selection procedure.
8. At the end of the interview, the Admission Committee assigns each candidate a score on a scale from 1 to 10. Candidates who receive a score of 7 or higher shall be deemed to have passed the selection.
9. The Admission Committee shall draw up separate ranking lists for each curriculum and research topic. In the event of equal scores, priority shall be given to the youngest candidate.
10. **If no suitable candidates are identified for a specific research topic, the corresponding position shall not be assigned.**
11. The selection documents and ranking lists for each curriculum and research topic shall be approved by Rector's Decree, which shall identify the successful candidates from among the eligible candidates, within the limits of the number of available positions.
12. **Successful candidates awarded a scholarship-funded place may not enrol without accepting the scholarship.**
13. The ranking lists and the list of successful candidates will be published exclusively on the webpage <https://www.unimc.it/it/dottorato-di-ricerca/ammissione-ai-corsi/ciclo-42-din/din2026>, and such publication shall constitute official notification for all purposes.
14. The individual evaluation reports issued by the Admission Committee will be made available to each candidate via the application platform (Art. 3, paragraph 1) at the end of the selection procedure, in accordance with the European Charter for Researchers and the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers.

Art. 6

Enrolment in the doctoral programme

1. The successful candidates identified by Rector's Decree **must complete their enrolment by 11:59 p.m. (Italian time) on 15 October 2026, under penalty of exclusion.**
2. The winners will not receive any further notice regarding the enrolment deadline.
3. **Enrolment in a type of position different from the one awarded is not permitted.**
4. Failure to obtain the required admission degree by the deadline set out in paragraph 1 of this Article shall result in non-admission to the Doctoral programme and ineligibility for enrolment.
5. To complete enrolment in the Doctoral programme, successful candidates are required to:
 - a) log in at <https://sis.unimc.it> and complete the enrolment form by the deadline indicated in paragraph 1 of this Article;
 - b) pay the first instalment of the applicable tuition fees and/or contributions (Piano tasse) by the deadline indicated in paragraph 1 of this Article;
 - c) upload the following documents in the "Attachments" section of the enrolment form:
 - [Dichiarazione del percipiente](#) (*all scholarship winners*);
 - ISEE-U 2026 declaration or ISEE for doctoral programme 2026 declaration (*for scholarship winners who wish to benefit from a reduction in tuition fees*);
 - copy of the residence permit or of the receipt confirming the application for a residence permit (*for non-EU citizens already in Italy only*).
6. **The University must receive the enrolment form and payment of the due tuition fees and/or contributions by the deadline indicated in paragraph 1 of this Article in order to confirm acceptance of the position and complete enrolment.**
7. Fees and/or enrolment contributions will not be refunded under any circumstances.

8. Failure to complete enrolment by the deadline indicated in paragraph 1 of this Article shall be deemed a tacit withdrawal.
9. In cases of express or tacit withdrawal from enrolment, the University shall proceed with ranking-list progression and offer the available position to the next eligible candidate, pursuant to Art. 5, paragraphs 9 and 10.
10. The University will use the contact email address provided in the online application to inform the next eligible candidate of the instructions and deadline for accepting the position.
11. Enrolment in a Doctoral programme is compatible with simultaneous enrolment in other university degree programmes pursuant to Law No. 33 of 12 April 2022.

Art. 7

Additional requirements for candidates with foreign qualifications and visa applicants

1. Successful candidates with admission qualifications obtained in non-EU countries who have not already provided documentation useful for verifying the authenticity and equivalence/comparability of the second-level qualification for admission purposes only when submitting the application (e.g. Diploma Supplement, Declaration of Value issued by the Italian diplomatic authorities in the country where the qualification was obtained, or certificates of authenticity and comparability issued by centres such as ENIC-NARIC) must provide such documentation during enrolment (online in the "Attachments" section) or, in any event, **within one month of the start date of the Doctoral programme**.
2. The University reserves the right to request documentation verifying the authenticity and equivalence/comparability of qualifications obtained in EU countries, and to request submission of the original documentation.
3. Candidates with foreign qualifications who do not submit the required documentation at the time of application or enrolment shall be provisionally enrolled and shall subsequently be excluded from the Doctoral programme if they fail to provide the requested documentation or if, upon verification, the qualification does not meet the requirements set out in Art. 2. In such cases, any scholarship payments received must be repaid.
4. After completing enrolment, candidates who require a visa to stay in Italy must register on the [University portal](#), submit a pre-enrolment application for the Doctoral programme and follow the procedure indicated therein for the purpose of obtaining a visa.
5. Upon arrival in Italy, candidates are required to promptly send the following documents to scuola.dottorato@unimc.it for the purpose of scholarship payment:
 - a) a valid residence permit. Candidates who do not have a valid residence permit must apply for one within 8 days of arriving in Italy, following the procedure indicated on the [University Portal](#), and send a copy of the application receipt issued by the Questura (local police headquarters);
 - b) Italian tax code (codice fiscale), issued by the Italian Revenue Agency. Candidates who do not have one must apply for it by following the instructions on the [University Portal](#);
 - c) copy of a health insurance policy (*for non-EU citizens only*).

Art. 8

Scholarships

1. The scholarship for attending the Doctoral programme, set by [Ministerial Decree No. 247 of 23 February 2022](#), amounts to **EUR 16,243.00 gross per year**, payable to the recipient.
2. Scholarship recipients must register with the INPS Separate Pension Scheme (Gestione Separata INPS), pursuant to Art. 2, paragraph 26 of Law No. 335 of 8 August 1995; the tax provisions set out in Art. 4 of Law No. 476 of 13 August 1984 shall apply.

3. Scholarship holders who intend to carry out paid activities during the three-year Doctoral programme must be authorised by the Academic Board to attend the programme while carrying out such activities. **The gross annual personal taxable income compatible with the doctoral scholarship must not exceed the amount of the scholarship defined by the Ministry, as referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article.**
4. **Compliance with the aforementioned limit will be assessed by the University administration from the first tax period following the start date of the Doctoral programme. If the gross annual personal taxable income exceeds the established limit, the scholarship shall be suspended and the scholarship holder shall be required to repay any monthly instalments unduly received.**
5. The scholarship may not be combined with a research fellowship or with any other scholarship, except for scholarships awarded by Italian or foreign institutions to support periods of study and research abroad.
6. The scholarship is awarded annually and is confirmed by the Academic Board, subject to successful completion of the assessments required for admission to the following year.
7. The scholarship is increased by 50% **for research activities carried out abroad**, subject to prior authorisation by the doctoral student's supervisor, for a total period of **six months**.
8. The first two monthly instalments of the scholarship will be paid together in December 2026.
9. Payment of the scholarship is conditional upon submission of the Italian tax code (codice fiscale), issued by the Italian Revenue Agency.
10. Receipt of the scholarship does not establish an employment relationship with the University.

Art. 9

Funding for research activities

1. For research activities in Italy and abroad, **each doctoral student** enrolled in the National Doctoral Programme is granted an annual research budget equal to 20% of the scholarship amount, in accordance with Art. 9, paragraph 4 of Ministerial Decree No. 226 of 14 December 2021.
2. Doctoral students **without a scholarship** shall benefit from an international mobility contribution, paid as reimbursement of expenses incurred for **six months** of research activity abroad.

Art. 10

Regional grants for the right to study

1. Applicants to the selection procedure for admission to the Doctoral programme may apply for benefits from the Regional Authority for the Right to University Education (Ente Regionale per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario - ERDIS), in accordance with the provisions set out in the specific ERDIS calls, available at <https://erdis.it/>.

Art. 11

University charges and fees

1. Charges (regional tax for the right to higher education, third-party liability insurance premium and stamp duty) and the annual all-inclusive university fee (Contributo Onnicomprensivo Annuale, COA) for attending doctoral programmes are indicated on the webpage: <https://www.unimc.it/it/dottorato-di-ricerca/dottorandi/iscrizioni-e-tasse>.
2. The amount of the annual all-inclusive university fee (COA) depends on the ISEE-U declaration or ISEE for doctoral studies declaration, in accordance with the Student Contribution Regulations, available at <https://www.unimc.it/it/ateneo/normativa/regolamenti-di-ateneo/didattica-e-studenti>.
3. Pursuant to paragraph 262 of the 2017 Stability Law (Law No. 232 of 11 December 2016), PhD students without a scholarship are exempt from paying enrolment fees. They are nevertheless required to pay the regional tax for the right to higher education, civil liability insurance and stamp duty.

4. Exemption from the annual all-inclusive university fee (COA) is granted to individuals with a recognised disability, under national legislation, equal to or greater than 66%.
5. Withdrawal after enrolment or during the doctoral programme does not entitle the student to a refund of paid charges and fees.

Art. 12

Personal Data Processing

1. In accordance with Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR), the University of Macerata undertakes to respect the confidentiality of the information provided by candidates: all personal data will be processed solely for purposes connected with and instrumental to this call, in accordance with the legislation in force.
2. The Data Controller is the University of Macerata, with registered office in Macerata, via Crescimbeni 30-32, represented by the Rector as legal representative. The Data Controller may be contacted at urp@unimc.it or at the certified email address (PEC) ateneo@pec.unimc.it.
3. The Data Protection Officer, appointed pursuant to Article 37 of the GDPR, operates within the Data Controller's organisation. The Data Protection Officer may be contacted at dpo@unimc.it.
4. All selection procedure records are public. In accordance with Law No. 241 of 7 August 1990, any person with a legally relevant interest is entitled to exercise the right of access to those records within 60 days of their approval.

Art. 13

Art. 14

Final Provisions

1. Doctoral students are required to comply with the Code of Ethics of the University of Macerata.
2. For all matters not provided for in this call for applications, reference shall be made to the Regulations concerning procedures for the accreditation of institutions and doctoral programmes and criteria for the establishment of doctoral programmes by accredited institutions (Ministerial Decree No. 226 of 14 December 2021), as well as to the University Doctoral Regulations (Rector's Decree No. 81 of 1 March 2023).
3. In the event of discrepancies between the two language versions of this call for applications, the Italian language version shall prevail.
