SLM: A linguistic model for psychological support	<p><u>Description of activities</u></p> <p>The project is highly multidisciplinary, crossing aspects of constitutional law, applied economics and computer engineering.</p> <p>The research focuses on creating an SLM for emotional support in the field of psychology and develops a chatbot with a user-friendly user interface. The model must guarantee wide accessibility both to industry experts and to the public of end users.</p> <p>On the legal side, the research concerns the regulatory framework of AI in a transnational context.</p> <p>The emphasis is placed on the comparison between different regulatory approaches that are emerging at an international level regarding the control that can be placed between humans and machines.</p> <p><u>Obligations for fellows</u></p> <p>Periods of study and research at the operational headquarters of the Synapsia s.r.l. company. for at least six (6) months, even if not continuous, over the three-year period 01/11/2024 – 31/10/2027.</p> <p>Periods of study and research abroad at the headquarters of BEIJING NORMAL UNIVERSITY (Beijing-China) for at least six (6) months, even non-continuously, over the three-year period 01/11/2024 – 31/10/2027.</p>
Subjects on which the INTERVIEW will focus	Presentation and critical discussion of the research project; assessment of knowledge relating to the indicated research topic; knowledge of foreign languages
