## **Lectures on Research Methods**

## Aims and scope

The aim of this cycle of methodological lectures is to offer Ph.D. students in Global Studies a general framework for research methodology.

Considering the interdisciplinary nature of the doctorate and various constraints, the cycle will be of a general nature and will aim to introduce the various research methods.

The cycle of seminars is divided into several modules. In each seminar, there will be part of traditional lectures, and a part of interactive teaching, in which Ph.D. students will be invited to interact directly with lecturers, proposing their research design.

## Program and learning objectives

Module 1. Introduction to research methods

Paradigms of social research; research design; empirical translation of theory: hypothesis and formulation of research questions; how to approach a Ph.D. dissertation; how to write a scientific paper

Module 2. Quantitative research

Introduction to quantitative methods; rudiments of statistics and logic of statistical inference; univariate, bivariate, and multivariate analysis; application of quantitative methods

Module 3. Qualitative research

Introduction to qualitative methods; qualitative research techniques (interviews and creative techniques); content analysis of empirical data
